## TOPIC 6: Project Planning and Monitoring



## **Target Participants**

Middle and Senior level Officers / executives of Public Sector Enterprises (both CPEs and SLPEs) who are responsible for project planning, formulation, implementation, monitoring and evaluation are ideally suited to attend this programme.

## **Objectives**

The Programme is intended to provide a broad management perspective for project planning and monitoring with the following objectives:

- To acquaint the participants with tools and techniques to develop effective project planning, methodical scheduling, professional implementation, scientific monitoring systems and systematic evaluation procedures for various projects in Public Sector environment;
- To appraise the participants and update their knowledge on advanced areas and best practices in project management;
- To enhance the understanding and appreciation of various legal and operational aspects of project formulation, implementation, monitoring and evaluation.

## **Programme Rationale**

Recent developments in the competitive environment - global as well as domestic, and enhanced emphasis of Government of India on optimizing the performance of Public Sector Enterprises (both CPSEs and SLPEs) have resulted in significant changes in the manner in which projects are formulated, planned and monitored. Executives, today, are encountering a challenging environment characterized by complexities in planning, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating their projects. Failure in planning and monitoring of projects not only results in financial losses but also has a cascading adverse effect on project performance, in terms of disruption of work; counterproductive activities like arbitration and litigation; loss of goodwill; and so on. As a result, managing projects (right from the planning stage to the evaluation stage through a methodic implementation and monitoring) has become a key factor for the success of middle and senior level managers / executives.

The proposed training programme will aim towards meeting the current needs of a middle or senior level executive both from the organizational and individual perspective. The programme adopts an interactive approach, with



a judicious blend of pedagogical tools like Lectures, Case Studies, Action Learning Project and so on.
